Adam Greenland is the National Hydrographer at Land Information New Zealand (LINZ). He is responsible for the Hydrographic Data Infrastructure which produces and maintains official nautical charts and publications for safe navigation. Working in the New Zealand Hydrographic Authority at LINZ for the past 6 years, Adam represents New Zealand at International Hydrographic Organisation (IHO) meetings and is a recent member of the New Zealand Geographic Board (NZGB).

He holds a Merchant Navy Deck Officer certificate of Competency, a tertiary qualification in Hydrographic Surveying and Mapping Sciences, a Post Graduate Diploma in Management and is a Member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors.

Among his responsibilities, Adam heads the delegation that represents New Zealand on the IHO Hydrographic Commission of Antarctica (HCA) and the South West Pacific Regional Hydrographic Commission (SWPHC). He is also a Board member of the IHO/FIG/ICA International Board of Standards of Competence.

Adam has previously held roles at the Port of London Authority, which included Deputy Port Hydrographer.
